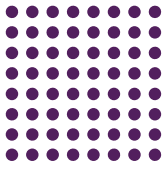




File Format

We prefer print-ready artwork in PDF format. This ensures that the design elements are preserved and ready for printing.



Resolution

Your artwork should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi (dots per inch) to ensure high-quality prints. Low-resolution images may appear pixelated or blurry when printed.



Bleed & Trims

Please include a bleed of at least 3mm around all edges of your artwork and include trim marks. This ensures that there are no white borders when the final prints are trimmed.



Colour Mode

Please ensure your artwork is in CMYK colour mode for full-colour prints. This helps to accurately represent colours in the final prints. If your artwork is in RGB mode, there will be a variation in colours when printed. Please note that the colours that appear on the screen do not accurately represent the final printed colours.



Proofreading

Before submitting your artwork, please double-check spelling, grammar, and design elements to ensure accuracy. Changes may incur additional charges once the artwork is submitted and delay the printing process.
